



## Atlanta Memorial Park Conservancy Annual Membership Drive Campaign Fast Facts

**Campaign Goal:** \$359,000

**Raised to Date:** \$153,051 or 43% of Goal

**What Your Dollars Do:** Your Membership enables AMPC to complete its first step of raising funds for its ongoing operations. The funds raised to date made it possible for AMPC to hire an Executive Director in April of this year to run the organization, continue to build on its relationships throughout the community and within the City's government, and lead the efforts to raise funds that will allow Phases I and II to be implemented as outlined below. A successful Annual Membership Drive will ensure that AMPC will continue in its mission *to make Atlanta Memorial Park a beautiful, environmentally sensitive and sustainable park, accessible and connected to the neighborhoods, and the City, by enhancing the Park, tennis and golf experiences through a collaborative process of renovation, restoration and preservation.*

### PHASE I:

- Stream Restoration Management
- Enhance Walkability through Upgraded System of Paths and Trails
- Restore Landscape with Native Materials
- Remove Invasive Plants
- Reorganize Lawn and Tree Plantings
- Removal of Dying Trees
- Raise Canopy for Visibility
- Replace Curbing along Wesley Drive
- Develop Long-term Landscape Management Plan

### PHASE II:

- Flood Mitigation and Improved Water Filtration along Peachtree and Tanyard Creeks
- Improvements to Creeks and Creek Beds
- Enhanced Connectivity through New Walking and Cycling Paths
- Improved Tennis Facilities including Relocated Tennis Hard Courts with Six Additional Courts
- Renovate the Golf Course using Current Best Practices for Sustainable, Environmentally-Friendly Course Design and Maintenance: proposed options include a newly designed reversible 9-hole course with an instructional and practice facility or a newly renovated 18-hole course
- Repurpose the Existing Golf Clubhouse to Create a More Attractive and Efficient Space for the Community
- Build a New Clubhouse to be Located Near the Bitsy Grant Tennis Center
- Create Adequate and Safe Parking that Removes Cars from Side Streets and Driveways and Improves Traffic Flow
