More Updates

~Peachtree Creek Capacity Relief Project by the Department of Watershed Protection will bring online July 1 the Liddell Drive Equalization Facility. This facility will moderate the flow of sewer water during storm events with the intent of minimizing sewer overflows including those that take place within the park.

~GDOT continues to review plans for the proposed new bridge at Northside Drive and Woodward Way. Efforts are being taken to keep the height of the new bridge to a minimum. Updates should take place in June.

~Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs continues to move forward with adoption of the draft master plan.

~PATH continues to work on designs completing the Tanyard Creek PATH up to Northside Drive. The Trail Committee of the Conservancy as well as Bob Hughes of HGOR, our master planner, continue to be a part of this process.
