



BRIEF HISTORY OF THE 101 GDOT TREES

- The original tree planting plan originated in 2012 for the construction of the PATH Northwest Connector Trail on Northside Drive adjacent to the golf course.
- GDOT assumed responsibility for the tree planting and trail construction plans during the Northside Drive Roadway Project.
- In early 2018, AMPC and the Springlake Civic Association met to discuss the trees that were planned but not yet planted.
- All of the partners listed on this brochure came together to ensure that the GDOT trees would be planted prior to the closing out of the contract.

MORE ON THE 101 GDOT TREE PLANTINGS

- The target date for GDOT tree planting is by year-end 2018.
- GDOT tree selection and location were based on the pre-set contractual requirements under the existing GDOT Northside Drive Roadway Project.
- The GDOT trees have been staked on site for the community to view and discuss during the Walk and Talk on 11/17.
- The 101 GDOT trees to be planted will be paid for by GDOT under the existing Northside Drive Roadway Project contract.

OTHER DETAILS

- The Bobby Jones Golf Course Foundation (BJGCF) will be planting additional trees and landscaping along the Northside Drive corridor under a separate landscape plan.
- The coordination with the BJGCF and HGOR was critical to the successful planting of the GDOT trees so that both plans would work in harmony with one another.
