Workshop No. I for Atlanta Memorial Park was held on Saturday, June 15, 2013. The workshop was organized by the Atlanta Memorial Park Conservancy as the basis for developing a long-term master plan to guide future park improvements.

The workshop was organized to address and solicit input on four key areas:

- Park setting, environment and image
- 2. Creek, trails and leisure activities
- 3. Tennis for success
- Golf as Bobby would have it

Approximately one hundred people were in attendance, representing adjacent neighborhoods, the larger city and the region.

To allow for a variety of dialogue, participants were seated at tables in groups of eight. Each table included a professional facilitator to assist in the process.

Issues were first discussed at each table and then each table was asked to present a synopsis of the discussion. They were also asked to put forth the one item which created the most energy and importance from their discussions.

The items were listed and then utilizing electronic keypad voting, the entire group voted for their individual, top three issues. The votes were tabulated instantly and the results were projected for all to see.

The following illustrates a synopsis of the voting results along with a tally sheet of the number of times an issue was listed by participants and a summary of written comments.





PARTICIPANT DEMOGRAPHICS











Discussion Issue #1- Park Setting, Environment & Image

Concerns:

- I. The Health & Stability of the Watershed
 - a. Flooding, Creek Pollution and Smell of Sewage
- 2. Traffic & Parking
 - a. Originally separated into different issues, but very great concern- not enough parking, nuisance to residence in area, parallel parking on Woodward Way
- 3. Safety
 - Crossing Northside, Trail Safety, Theft, more people= more issues

Hopes:

- I. Stronger Connectivity
 - a. More trails joining neighborhoods together, allowing more foot and bike traffic, and a connection to the BeltLine
- 2. Greenspace Management, Environmental Protection and Upkeep
 - Voice for more Greenspace, Preservation of Trees,

 - Great support for a variety of Outdoor Activities-Playground, openspace, basketball, pool



Hopes:


- I. Improvement & Expansion of Trails
 - a. Overwhelming desire for a Loop Trail with a variety of shorter loop trail systems, which allow for exploration. Strong support for porous concrete, rubber material or woodchips for trails
- 2. Trail Amenities
 - a. Desire for restrooms, water fountains, and signage, as well as destination points (Community Garden, Pool, Basketball)
- 3. Healthier Creek
 - a. Make approachable for potential fishing and and nature exploration with the possibility for pedestrian bridges and crossings



 - either way- There is a strong desire to keep 18, as well as a push for a world-renown 9 Hole Course with a state-of-the-art Practice Facility and Driving Range.

There seems to be an aspiration to purchase Colonial Homes. Looks like this topic was not discussed until the end of the workshop, but everyone began writing about it towards the end of the discussion.

Conclusion from Bob Cupp, renown Golf Course Designer:

"The biggest thing is that the nine vs. eighteen is a very sensitive issue but it seems evenly divided. The Friends of Bobby Jones are eighteen, pretty much everyone else is nine and a range.

All understand that we cannot cure the flooding but we can improve the courses recovery time following a flood.

The trees have not been much if an issue because all of the studies I have done do not show the loss of many of the big oaks in the low portion of the property".
