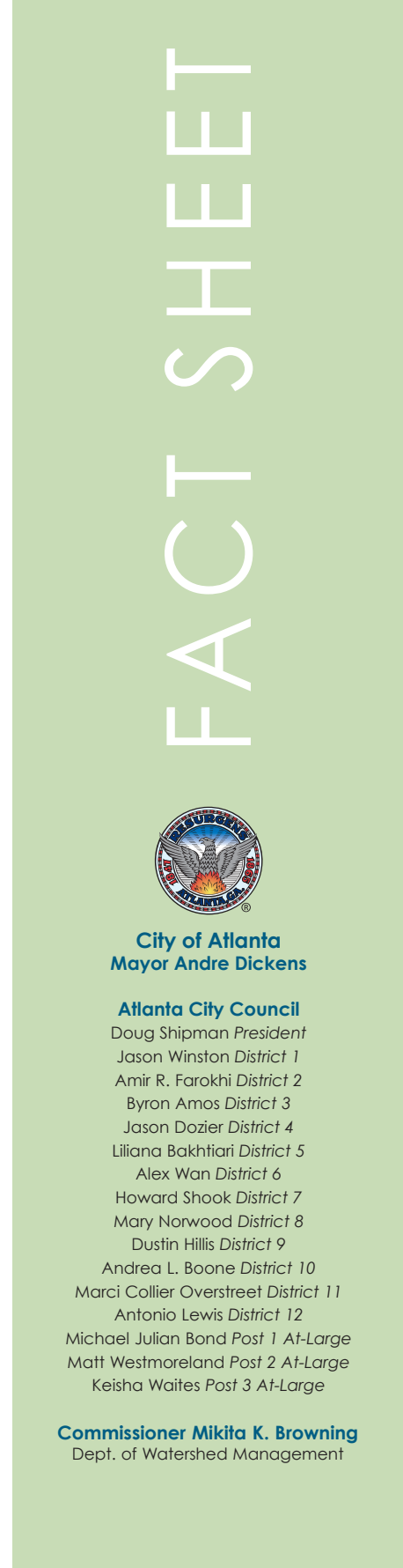

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The City of Atlanta Department of Watershed Management will construct the North Fork Storage Tank and Pump Station (North Fork STPS) on the Georgia Department of Transportation site near the intersection of Sidney Marcus Blvd and Buford Highway.

The North Fork STPS facility will include:

- 15-MG storage tank
- 75 MGD pump station
- Equipment control building
- Diversion structure

COMMUNITY IMPACTS

The construction of this facility will impact traffic along Sidney Marcus Boulevard, the Buford-Spring Connector and Lindberg Drive. Residents and businesses may experience: noise, temporary disruption of water service, partial or temporary lane and road closures, and Cheshire Farm Trail closures (under GA 400 and near I-85).

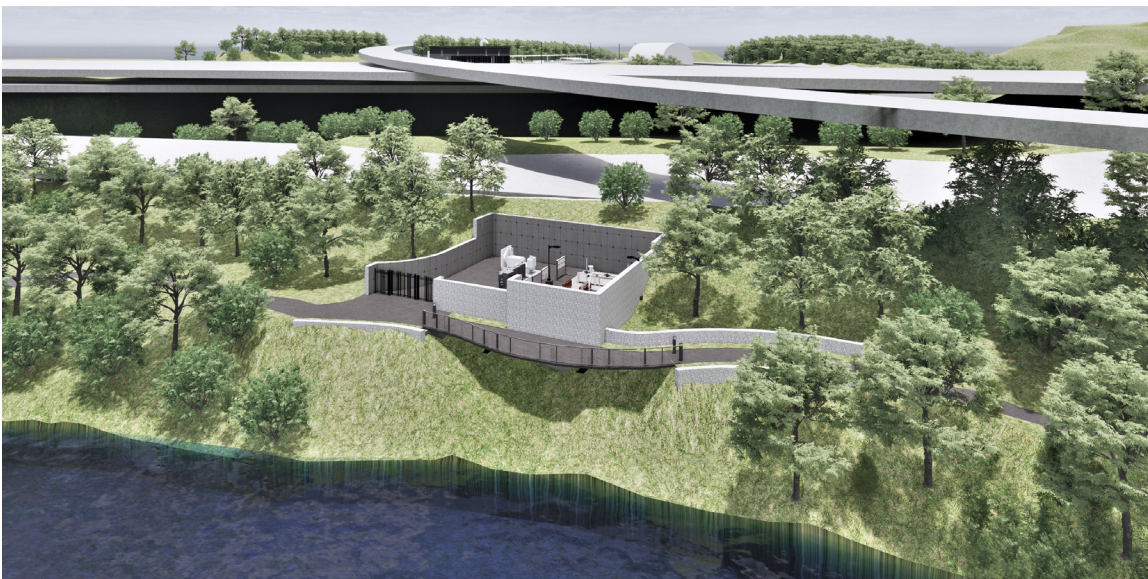
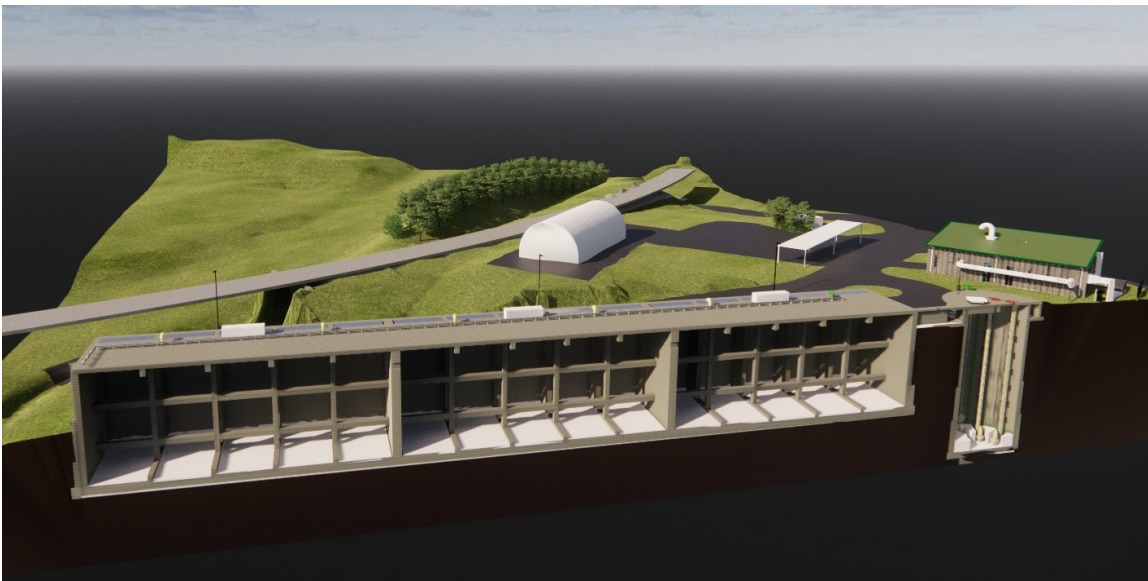
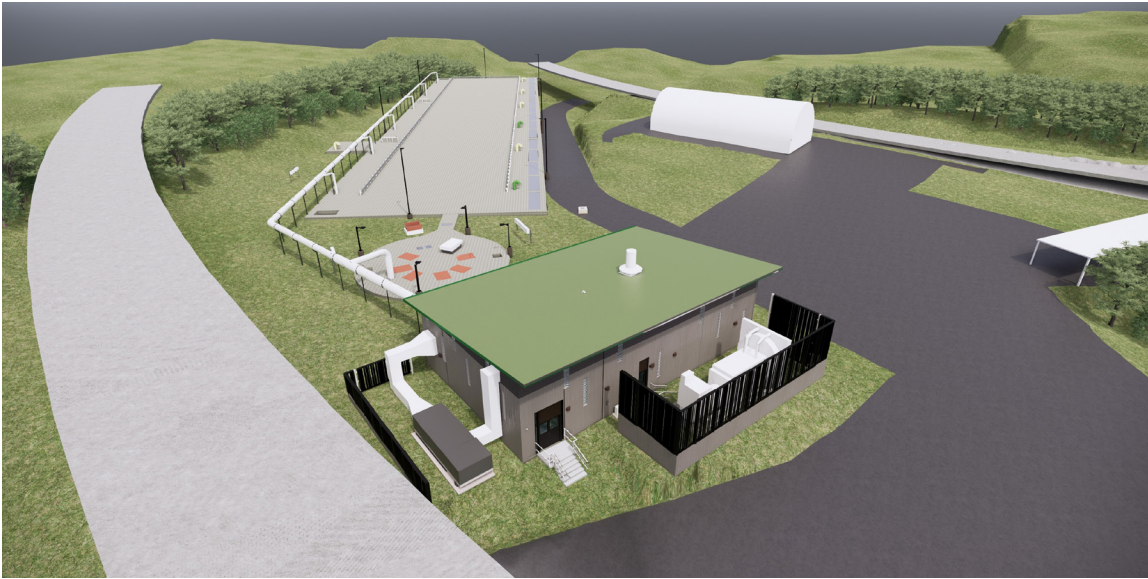
PROJECT BENEFITS

The improvements will ensure adequate capacity to significantly reduce the number and volume of sewer overflows while meeting the requirements of the Second Amendment to the First Amended Consent Decree.

Additionally, the storage facility is designed to capture runoff from major storm events that can overload the collection system and cause sanitary overflows. The Cheshire Farm Trail will also be widened and stabilized with overlook areas, a permeable surface and retaining walls.
