**Our Mission:** *The mission of the Atlanta Memorial Park Conservancy (AMPC) is to restore, enhance, and preserve Atlanta Memorial Park, making it a beautiful, connected, and sustainable urban greenspace for the enjoyment of all.*

**Our Focus:** *We are accomplishing our mission through collaboration and partnership focusing on three core areas:*

### **GREENSPACE, WATERSHED, and CONNECTIVITY**

Since its founding in 2011, AMPC has partnered with the City of Atlanta to provide the ongoing resources necessary to restore, enhance, and preserve Atlanta Memorial Park, including specifically **watershed, connectivity, and greenspace** improvements—with a **heightened emphasis on revitalizing the Park's watershed.**

### **OUR WORK**

As we look ahead to 2025, AMPC invites you to join us in a call to action. Our mission is more important than ever, especially in the wake of the flood damage caused by Hurricane Helene to both the Park and surrounding homes.

While we cannot prevent flooding in this vital floodplain, we are committed to improving the resilience of Peachtree Creek and its streambanks. AMPC, in collaboration with the City of Atlanta, will be part of a Task Force to address and implement long-term **restoration and rehabilitation solutions** for Peachtree Creek.

### **A SUMMARY OF KEY MILESTONES**

As we look to the future, it's important to reflect on our journey along the way, celebrating the significant milestones achieved since the Park's master plan was first envisioned in 2013:

- **The Atlanta Opera's recent announcement** of a \$45MM renovation of the historic Bobby Jones clubhouse on Woodward Way.
- **\$200MM+ in sewer upgrades**, including the ongoing construction of a new storage tank on the north fork of Peachtree Creek.
- **Over 5 miles of connectivity** through sidewalks, the NW Beltline Connector trail, the underpass at the Northside Drive bridge, and meandering nature trails.
- **Ongoing improvements** in pedestrian safety and enhancements to the Park corners.
- **Annual tree plantings** and **community volunteer days** dedicated to removing invasive plants from the Park and trash from Peachtree Creek.
- **Renovation of the Bobby Jones Golf Course**, originally designed by AMPC, funded and completed by the Bobby Jones Golf Course Foundation.
